Wisconsin Avenue Giant Proposal — The Zoning Commission held the first of its hearings on the proposal to redevelop the area around the Giant supermarket on Wisconsin Ave; there will be at least two more, the next on April 6. A very unscientific poll conducted by the Cleveland Park listserv found 77% in favor of the proposal (205 votes), 17% (44) in favor with some conditions, and 6% opposed (16).
