The pair was also responsible for "WWII Memorial: A Testament to Freedom," which appeared when the Memorial was opened in 2004. The new film will be broadcast on WETA/Ch. 26 at 11 pm on Monday, May 25, and on MPTV/Ch. 22 the next day at 10 pm (check local listings).
