Rat Reminder. The date of the program on the special **zoning regulations for the Woodley Park commercial district** (the so-called "neighborhood commercial overlay district" rules) has been changed to 7:30 pm on Wednesday April 14 at Stanford (Connecticut Ave and Woodley Rd).

Twenty-five **trees will be planted** in our neighboring neighborhood, Woodland Normanstone, on Saturday, March 13, and everyone is invited to help. The group will assemble by 9 am at Woodland Drive and 32 St, plant trees and then enjoy a picnic lunch. Children's activities will follow lunch. RSVP with the names of each family member who will participate in the planting and the names and ages of the children who want to be involved in the children's activities.

When we think of construction projects in the neighborhood, we think of noise at 7 am (or earlier), dirt, trucks on narrow side streets and other delights. But some of our neighbors found that **construction can bring good things**. The developers of the Woodley Wardman project in the 2800 block of Connecticut Ave. needed to get to the rear of their buildings after our latest little snowfall, and so they plowed the alley and hauled away the snow, giving their neighbors the clearest alley in the city (except, perhaps, the one behind the Mayor's house).
