On Thursday, a number of neighbors told the DC Public Space Committee why they opposed the applications of the developer of the property at **2910 Garfield St** to use the "public space" around this property for parts of the houses it wants to build. Their opposition joined that of ANC3C, WPCA and CM Mary Cheh. The Committee did not grant the applications at the hearing, but tabled them until the developer submits revised plans. This doesn't end the matter. The developer needs public space approval at least for curb cuts for the required off-street parking, so there will definitely be more to come. Details on our website.

ANC elections. The <u>ANC system</u> was created in 1974 with the goal of providing residents a forum to discuss issues affecting their neighborhood and to take recommendations to various District government agencies. There are 37 ANCs in the District, each of which is divided into districts of approximately 2,000 people who vote for the commissioner to represent them. Woodley Park has three ANC commissioners (and a little part of a fourth). WPCA invited the candidates for these positions to submit information about themselves for the website; you can read what they had to say <u>here</u>.
