**Streets will be closed** along the <u>route of the Oyster-Adams' ¡VAMOS! 5K race/walk</u> during Sunday morning. 29th Street between Calvert Street and Woodley Road will be closed most of the morning (as early as 7:00 and as late as 10:00), and other streets along the route will open on a rolling basis as the last participants have passed. Note, MPD says that roads leading to the closed streets may also be closed.
