## **Woodley Park News**

We are trying to convince the DC Council to move the part of Woodley Park east of Connecticut Avenue into the same ward as the rest of the neighborhood. Recent activities to make that happen include: ANC 3C passed a <u>resolution in support</u> of such redistricting, WPCA submitted a <u>statement</u> urging the Council to make that change and several residents either testified in person or submitted written testimony.

If you can volunteer for an hour or so to help out at the **hazmat collection and paper shredding**, the morning of Saturday June 4th in the Maret School parking lot, please contact Anne-Marie Bairstow.

The most recent prognostication from the Federal Highway Administration is that the **entrances to Rock Creek Parkway** will be open the first week of July.

We reported earlier that Noodles & Company, a "fast-food establishment" under DC zoning rules, wants to locate at 2635 Connecticut Avenue, but needs special permission from the Board of Zoning Adjustment. As a result of negotiations among the restaurant, the property owner, ANC 3C and WPCA, an enclosure will be built across the rear of the property to house the building's trash receptacles, and a trash compactor will be provided for use by all the tenants. These agreements are to be incorporated in any BZA order granting Noodles' application. The full agreement is reflected in the ANC resolution adopted at its last meeting.
