## Woodley Park News

**Redistricting.** We are trying to convince the DC Council to move the part of Woodley Park east of Connecticut Avenue into the same ward as the rest of the neighborhood. You can see ANC 3C's [resolution in support](#) and WPCA's [statement](#) advocating such redistricting. The Council's Redistricting Subcommittee, however, has proposed a redistricting plan that does not include this change. The Council will hold a hearing on this proposal on Wednesday June 1st, and a number of people from the neighborhood are expected to testify. If you want to be heard, the hearing starts at 6 pm at John A. Wilson Building, Council Chamber- Room 500, 1350 Pennsylvania Ave. If you want to testify should contact [Carol Sadler](#) at (202) 724-8198 and provide your name and any organizational affiliation by 5 pm on Tuesday May 31st, and you should bring 20 copies of your written testimony to the hearing.
