**ANC Redistricting.** In the Spring, the DC Council adopted boundaries of the eight Wards to reflect the 2010 census. The next task is to adjust the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions and the districts in them in response to the population shifts in the ten years since the last census. Task forces have been established in each Ward to recommend new boundaries to the Council. The <u>overall boundaries of our ANC (3C)</u> will likely change, as will those of most if not all of the individual districts. There are several Woodley Park residents on the Ward 3 task force (including me). If you have any thoughts about this redistricting process, <u>let me know</u> and I can pass them on to the larger group.
