All Souls Memorial Episcopal Church is one of several churches formed in Woodley Park as the neighborhood began to grow in the early part of the 20th century. Next month it will be celebrating 100th birthday. On Saturday October 8th from noon to 3 pm, the parish is holding an open house featuring clowns, balloons, face-painting, food, tours of the stained glass windows of the church (which include windows by Louis Comfort Tiffany) and much more. At its meeting on September 19, ANC 3C adopted a <u>resolution</u> opposing certain of the changes proposed by the owner of **3000 Connecticut Ave.** In particular, the ANC opposed the construction of the three-story laminated glass clock tower and the grates on the tree boxes.
