The Office of Planning has (once again) modified its proposed changes to DC zoning rules concerning **accessory apartments** in neighborhoods like Woodley Park. In particular, it would now require a home owner to get special approval from the BZA to have an apartment in a garage or other secondary building. It also removed the minimum lot size requirement to have an apartment in the main building.
