The owner of the McDonalds near the Woodley Park Metro wants to redesign the exterior of the building. The new Connecticut Ave façade would be red and black, with two large golden arches. The 24th St side would be black. Drawings of the proposal are [on the website](#). Because the building is in the Woodley Park Historic District, exterior changes must be approved by the Historic Preservation Review Board after a public hearing.
