## Woodley Park News

**Business District Zoning.** Last month, WPCA voted to oppose a request by a business district landlord for an exception to the zoning rule that limits the number of restaurants in the area. The opposition was not based on the identity of the particular restaurant. It was based on the recognition that the limit on restaurants makes storefronts available for other types of businesses.

The following week, ANC3C voted to support that request by a vote of 4-2, with one abstention and one commissioner absent.

The Board of Zoning Adjustment will hold a hearing on the application on the morning of December 16 at 441 4th Street NW. Members of the public may testify at the hearing or may submit testimony or letters to the Board electronically.
