The **District Kitchen** restaurant (2606 Connecticut) has asked for a modification of its alcohol license to permit it to serve in its sidewalk café until 3 am Saturday and Sunday and 2 am on other days. It can now serve alcohol outside until 11:30 pm. Some members of the WPCA Board are concerned about the prospect of late-night open-air drinking, especially if neighboring Open City, Italian Pizza Kitchen and Medaterra follow along. WPCA will consider whether to protest this license change at a meeting on June 3 at 7:30 pm at Stanford (before the Board meeting). Please let us know what you think.

WPCA haz materials cleanout and shredding day. Saturday June 6, 9 to 11 am in the Maret School parking lot. See <u>DPW's website</u> for what we may -- and may not -- accept (you can ignore the shredding limits because we will have our own shredding truck). Please note that this is *not* for bulk trash -- just the items listed by DPW.

We reported in February that the Board of Zoning Adjustment had granted **Nando's** application for zoning fixes to permit it to locate in Woodley Park. The formal order released late last month limited the relief to five years because, the Board said, "an escape hatch is needed here" and "five years is the maximum period that can be permitted to pass before the Board should have an opportunity to determine whether the impact of Nando's operations matched the Board's predictions." Nando's has asked the Board to reconsider and eliminate the five-year review; WPCA opposed Nando's motion.
