The District Department of the Environment Fisheries and Wildlife Division has been updating its **Wildlife Action Plan** for the District. It will hold a community meeting to discuss the plan on Wednesday August 5 at 6:30 pm at the National Zoo Visitors Center.

The Community Preservation and Development Corporation and the Council for Court Excellence have a <u>survey</u> asking questions about perceptions of safety, opinions on how to improve neighborhood public safety and the relations between their community and the police.

It has been <u>reported</u> that Nando's will not move forward with its plan to open at 2631 Connecticut Ave because of a condition imposed by the BZA when it granted Nando's request for waivers of certain zoning rules.
