Woodley Park News

Cleveland Park Library. HPRB had its initial hearing on the plans to build a new branch library this week. Board members seemed generally supportive of the overall concept, but were concerned about the massing on the Newark St side (and, to a lesser extent, on the Macomb frontage), as well as architectural details like the orientation of limestone panels. One Board member described the library entrance as "pretty grim," so I suspect that will be among the changes that will be part of the new design that will be presented to the Board. WPCA filed a brief comment on the proposed library signage. ANC3C submitted an extensive resolution.

Wardman Tower. JBG, the owner of the property, and its landscape architect will discuss landscaping plans and project status generally. Wednesday January 13, 7:30 pm at the Marriott Wardman Park Hotel.

Zoo grounds hours. There is a new <u>online petition</u> asking the Zoo to retain its current hours for access to the Zoo grounds.
