Woodley Park News

JBG. JBG will make another presentation concerning its long-term plans for the Marriott Wardman Park property on Wednesday April 13, time and place to be announced. JBG wants to eliminate the hotel and replace it with several buildings that would be roughly 40 percent larger than the hotel.

JBG's counsel confirms that this is not a "matter-of-right" project -- JBG will need special permission from the DC Zoning Commission, in the form of a Planned Unit Development, to move ahead. You can read an overview of the PUD process here.

We also had a preliminary meeting with the Office of Planning and Historic Preservation staff involved with this project. They understand -- and share -- the neighborhood's concerns about the size of any further development on along Woodley Road and the loss of greenspace.

Library. On Thursday, HPRB found the latest <u>exterior design plans</u> for the Cleveland Park Library compatible with the historic district. The Board delegated remaining design review to HPO staff.
