As previously reported, a WPCA committee has been working on a revision of the design guidelines for the historic district. The purpose of the effort was to expressly include the rears of historic district rowhouses as worthy of preservation. The draft is on the website. Key new elements include

- Rear additions to houses are strongly discouraged.
- Small modifications to garages for larger cars may be acceptable.
- Garages should not be repurposed to serve as living or entertainment spaces.
- Roof decks on garages are not permitted.

If you have any comments on the draft, please send them to the <u>WPCA email address</u>. There will be a **special meeting to discuss**, **possibly amend and vote on the quidelines** on Wednesday May 18 at 7 pm at Stanford.

Also at the May 18 special meeting – At the meeting in April, it was reported that there appeared to solution for the noise issues at **Bar Civita**. As the planned solution has not yet been implemented, WPCA will again consider whether to protest the liquor license renewal as leverage to get the issue resolved.
