## **Woodley Park News**

The latest update from JBG on the Wardman Tower renovation is <u>on the website</u>. It looks like "substantial completion" has slipped at least a month from JBG's most recent September prediction.

JBG will describe a revision to its PUD applications on Thursday September 8, 7:30 pm at the Omni Shoreham.

The **Tree Canopy Protection** Amendment Act of 2016 recently became effective. It was enacted to address tree loss and to support tree replacement citywide. Its provisions include:

Expanding protections to more trees by reducing the size of "Special Trees" from 55 inches in circumference 44 inches.

Increasing the fee for Special Tree removal to pay \$55 per circumference inch (up from \$35).

Raising the fines for unlawful tree removal from \$100 to at least \$300 per circumference inch.

Using Tree Fund money for planting trees on District-managed properties, including schools and parks.

Creating a new category for protected trees called Heritage Trees, which are over 100 inches in circumference.
