This will be an opportunity for multiple District agencies to provide a general overview of the trends over the past year or so, as well as a chance for residents to ask questions. The Metropolitan Police Department, Second District, will hold its **Community Fall Festival** on Thursday October 31 from 4:30 to 8 pm at the Friendship Recreation Center, 4500 Van Ness St. Food, moon bounce, face painter, candy egg hunt (starting at 5:30), sack race, story time, slime station, pumpkin carving and more. Pumpkin-carving adults should <u>register in advance</u>. Costumes encouraged, but not required.

The **DC Comprehensive Plan** is legislation designed to guide the city's development in coming decades. The <u>2006 Plan</u> is now under review and amendment. The Council passed the overview chapter of the new Plan (the so-called <u>Framework Element</u>) earlier this month. It will make development easier and give the Zoning Commission greater flexibility in approving new projects. The Office of Planning has now released its recommendations (1500+ pages) for <u>amendments to the rest of the Plan</u>. OP did not adopt the <u>amendments proposed by WPCA</u> and supported by ANC3C, which were designed to ensure that any redevelopment of the Marriott Wardman Park site be done pursuant to a comprehensive planning process and to make it harder to simply add another building to that site. (OP also did not recommend a proposal to upzone the entire property.) Overall, OP's proposals will make considerations of neighborhood conservation and stability less important. OP will consider comments on its draft before finalizing it and sending it to the Council for consideration. It will hold an information session about its proposals on Saturday December 7 from 10 am to noon at Wilson High School.

At the **WPCA Fall Meeting**, members elected Courtney Tolbert, President; Peter Brusoe, VP; Warren Gorlick, Secretary; Stephanie Zobay, Treasurer; and John Goodman, Katie MacFarlane and Jeff Myers, Board members.
