2735 Connecticut Ave. The owner of this rowhouse wants to tack an addition onto the rear of the existing building. The resulting building would be roughly twice as deep as the current one, and the rear addition would be 20 feet taller than the existing structure in front. The renovated building would contain four two-bedroom and four one-bedroom units. The proposal complies with zoning regulations, but needs historic preservation approval. A copy of the plans are <u>on the website</u>.
