Whither Marriott Wardman Park Hotel? The hotel is owned by a limited liability corporation; Marriott operates the hotel under a contract with the LLC. The LLC is 80% owned by an affiliate of PacLife; a JBG affiliate owns the other 20%. The PacLife entity recently petitioned the court to dissolve the LLC, citing the owners' inability to agree on a path forward. The petition also asks the court to appoint a trustee or receiver to wind up the LLC. You can read about the case here and get a copy of the petition on the website.

DDoT gave WPCA members a status report on its **Connecticut Ave corridor study** in late July. A copy of the presentation is <u>on the website</u>.
