The BZA has denied the appeal of the **Carmel permits** for the former Marriott site. It found that all the structures on the lot constitute a single building under the zoning regs (because there are "meaningful connections" between them) and that the height was correctly measured. The vote was 4-0.

Royal Tobacco DC has applied for a license to operate a **medical cannabis dispensary** at 2604 Connecticut Ave. It would "provide cannabis flowers, cannabis concentrates, and a line of edible products and home delivery services to registered patients in Washington, D.C." The ABRA notice is on the website.
