Woodley Park News

Connecticut Ave Rezoning. OP has filed with the Zoning Commission to change the zoning for Connecticut Ave in Woodley Park and Cleveland Park. There are no surprises here -- this is essentially what they presented at our meeting in March.

In the 2021 amendments to the Comp Plan, the Council and Mayor decided that the future of the WP business district should allow taller, more dense buildings. OP's petition would carry out that decision. You can see the proposed changes in Table 2 on page 7 of OP's report. Buildings on the west side of the Ave could be 90 feet tall (plus a 15-foot penthouse), with 70-foot buildings on the east side (also plus penthouse). The east side limit is lower because those buildings back onto the low-scale rowhouses on Woodley Pl. (HPRB would still need to approve any proposed projects as being "compatible" with the historic district.) OP is also asking for the elimination of the 25% ground-floor restaurant cap. There will be opportunities to comment on OP's proposal before the ZC acts on it.

Metro's all-new **BetterBus network** premieres tomorrow. The last overhaul of the city's bus system was in 1973. Read all about the changes <u>here</u>.
