As reported last year, scheduling issues prevented WPCA from having its regular Fall meeting, so Board named members to serve on the Executive Committee until the next regular membership meeting of the Association. The Board proposes the following change to Section V.G of the Bylaws:

"The Executive Committee may remove any member of the Executive Committee who has not attended three consecutive ~~in-person~~ Executive Committee meetings...."
